RULES FOR THE USE OF FLAMENCO PUBLIC BEACH AND ITS CAMPGROUND

1. Users of campground shall provide the necessary equipment for their stay, including tents, cooking equipment, personal effects, and first aid supplies.
2. There is an area at Flamenco Public Beach for independent concessionaires who rent tents and beach equipment and sell food, basic items, and beach items. Visitors to the Culebra Public Beach are urged to patronize these businesses.
3. Camping is only permitted in the area that has been designated and identified for that purpose.
4. With the purpose of protecting the wildlife and vegetation of Flamenco Public Beach, the following activities are not permitted:
 - Disturbing, interfering with, or harming the wildlife of Culebra.
 - Cutting trees or any type of vegetation.
 - Bonfires outside the cooking facilities provided for that purpose.
 - Burying trash anywhere at Flamenco Public Beach.
 - Using lights on the beach, which can disorient the sea turtles.
 - Entering areas that have been identified and cordoned off as turtle nesting areas.
 - Throwing trash anywhere other than in the trashcans that Flamenco Public Beach provides.
5. To guarantee the safety, tranquility, and enjoyment of all visitors, the following activities will not be allowed on the area of Flamenco Public Beach:
 - Glass containers (all glass containers will be confiscated).
 - Using motor vehicles of any type on the beach.
 - Excessive volume of sound equipment.
 - Noise after 11:00 p.m.
 - Disorderly conduct, rude language, or nudity.
 - Firearms save for law enforcement officers.
 - Animals save for guide or police dogs.
 - Sleeping on the beach.
 - Excessive use of alcoholic beverages.
 - Electric generators or electric power extension cords.
